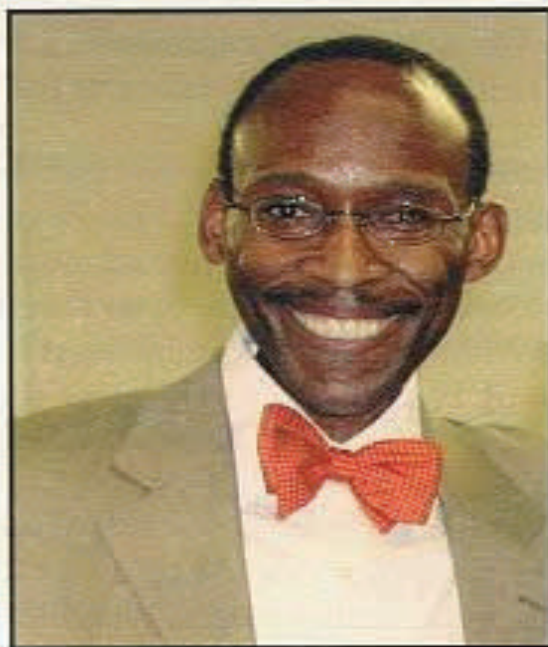

Obituary

Darryl Hale, Esquire the loving husband of Vera (Crawford) Hale and the devoted father of Hannah Elisabeth Hale passed away on Thursday, May 17, 2007 at Yale-New Haven hospital.

Darryl was born in Marysville, CA, the son of Preston Hale, Sr. and Ethel Mae (Calhoun) Hale. As a part of a military family, he had the opportunity to travel extensively during his younger years. Because of this experience, Darryl was able to easily relate to people from many different backgrounds.

Darryl was the valedictorian of Apollo High School in Glendale, AZ, and went on to receive his Bachelor of Science degree with honors in industrial labor relations from Cornell University. In 1986, he received his Juris Doctorate from Harvard Law School. Darryl began his legal career at Murtha Culina law firm of Hartford, CT. He spent the last 17 years as a field attorney for the National Labor Relations Board.

For over 20 years, Darryl demonstrated spiritual fervor—speaking and teaching diligently the things of the Lord. He conducted many bible study groups, visited the sick, prayed for those in need, and inspired many to seek God. For the last two years, he had the privilege and honor of being the pastor at New Born Church of God and True Holiness, Inc. in Newington, CT.

In addition to his wife, daughter, and parents, Darryl is survived by three brothers: Preston Hale, Jr. of Austin, TX; Christopher Hale of Durham, NC; and Gary Hale of Hartford, CT; and the New Born church family.

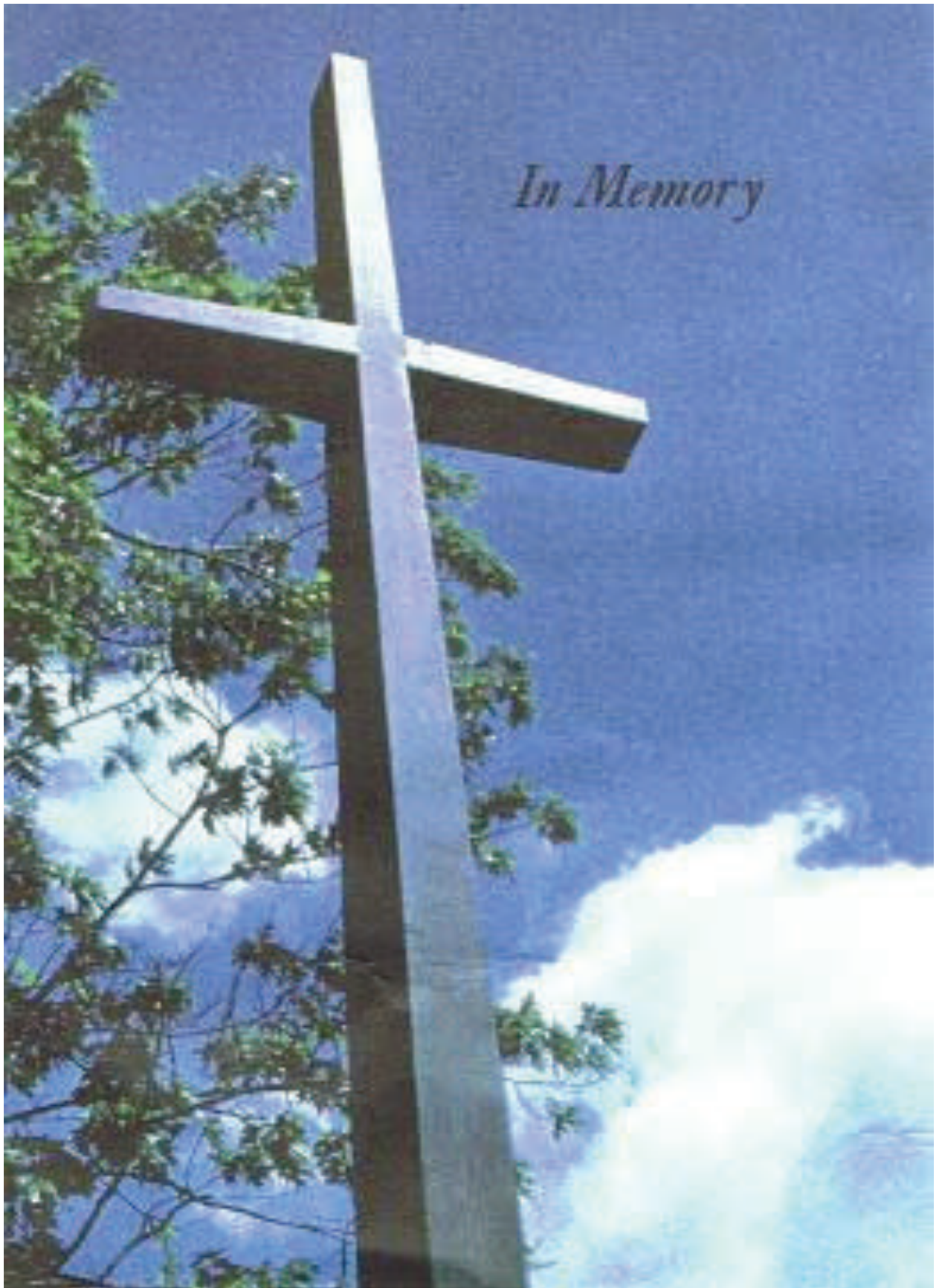
