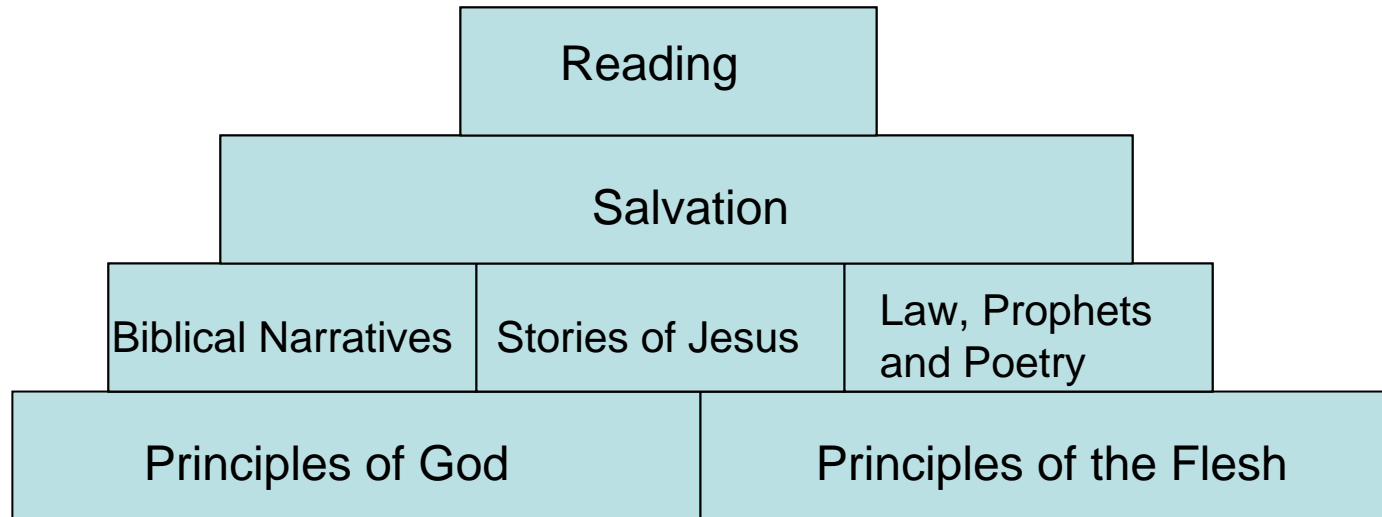

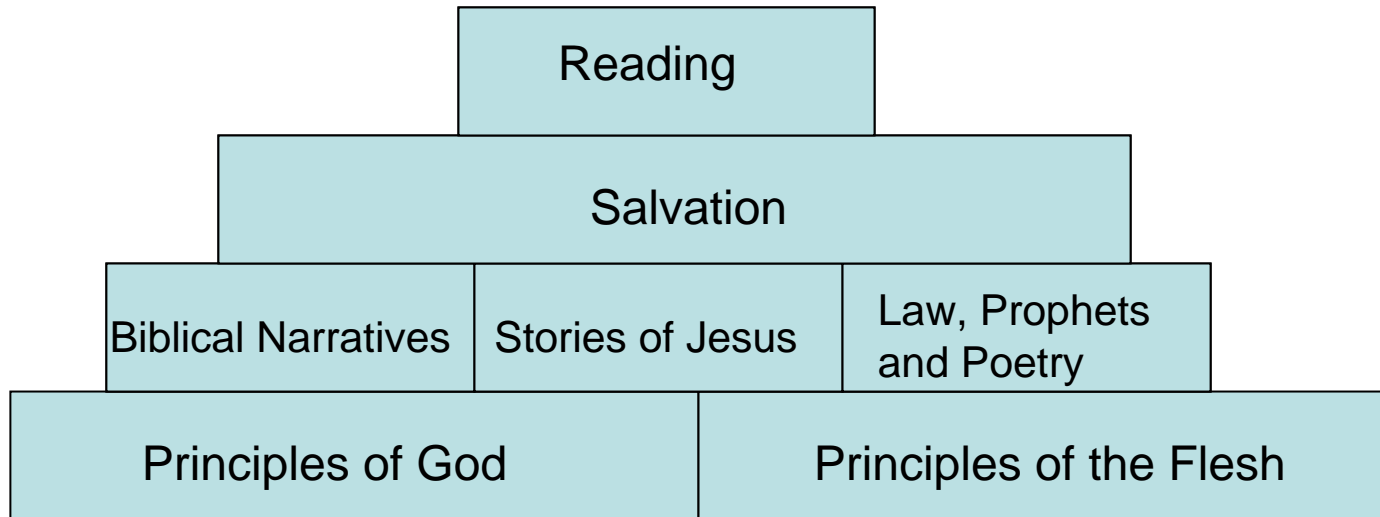
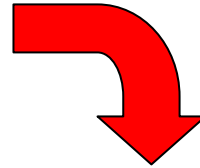
## The Building Blocks of Biblical Understanding

- The Bottom Layer (Foundation) is What Everything the Bible Teaches is Based on.
- Generally, People *Don't* Learn the Principles of Scripture from the Foundation Up, but the top down.



# Typical Top Down Approach to Understanding God

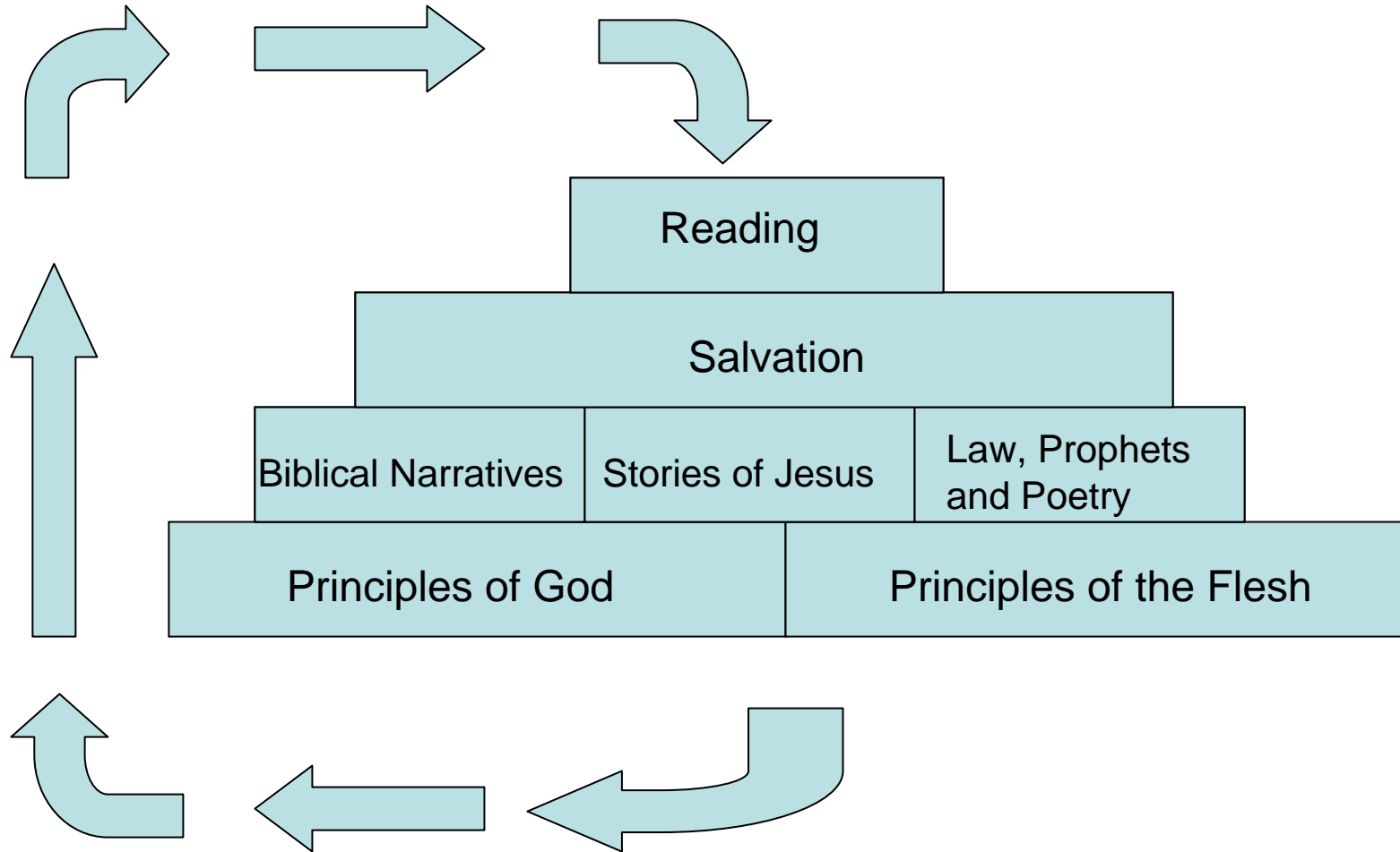

# Typical Approach

- Generally, the approach taken by bible students is to start reading the scriptures.
- The first thing we learn about is salvation.
- Then we begin to learn about the life of Jesus and other biblical characters.
- If we try long enough and have good teaching, we will begin to learn the basic foundational principles of the scriptures.

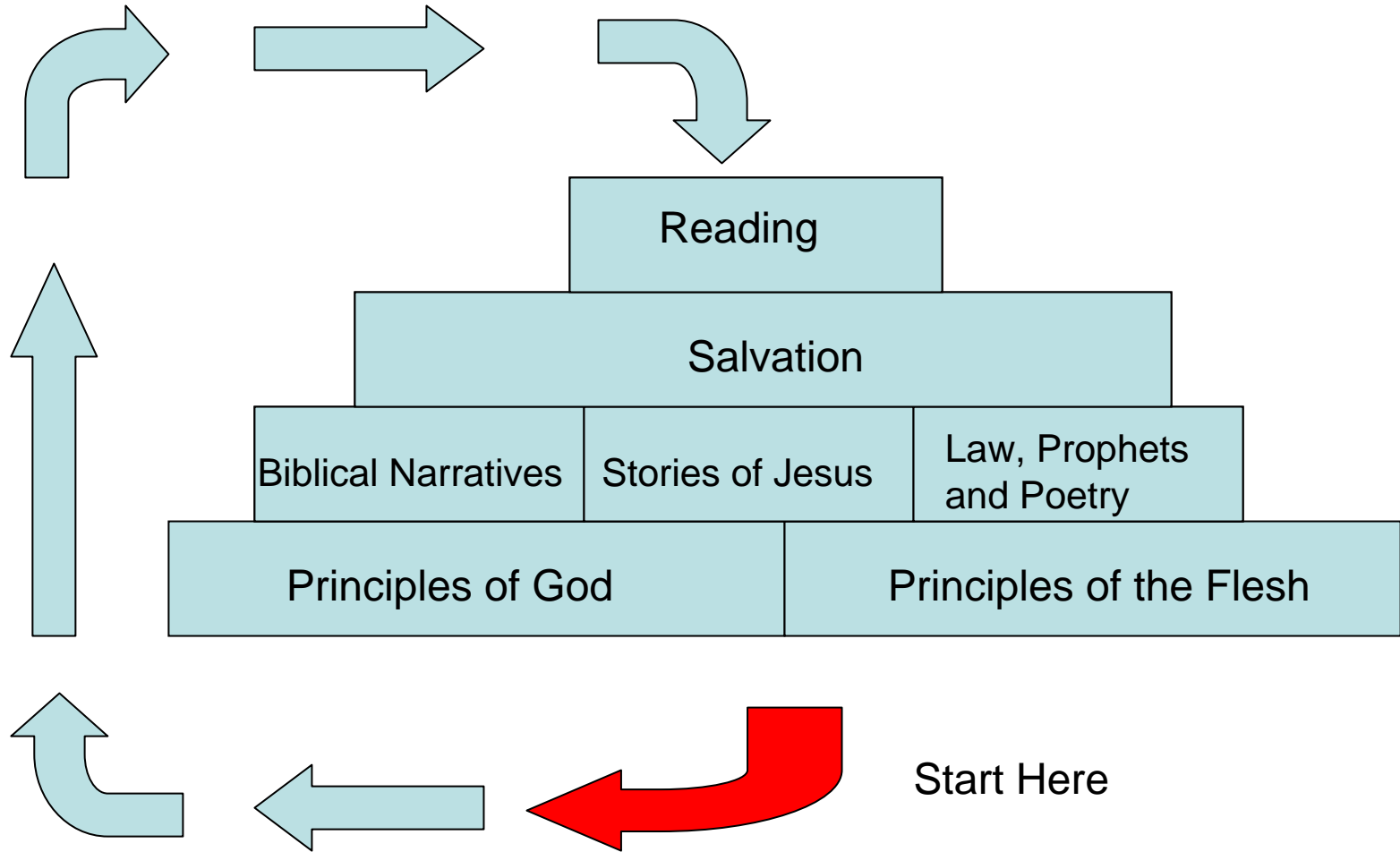
- Work Your Way Down Through Every Level.

- Sadly, Many People Have Spent Years on this Approach and Never Reach the Bottom.



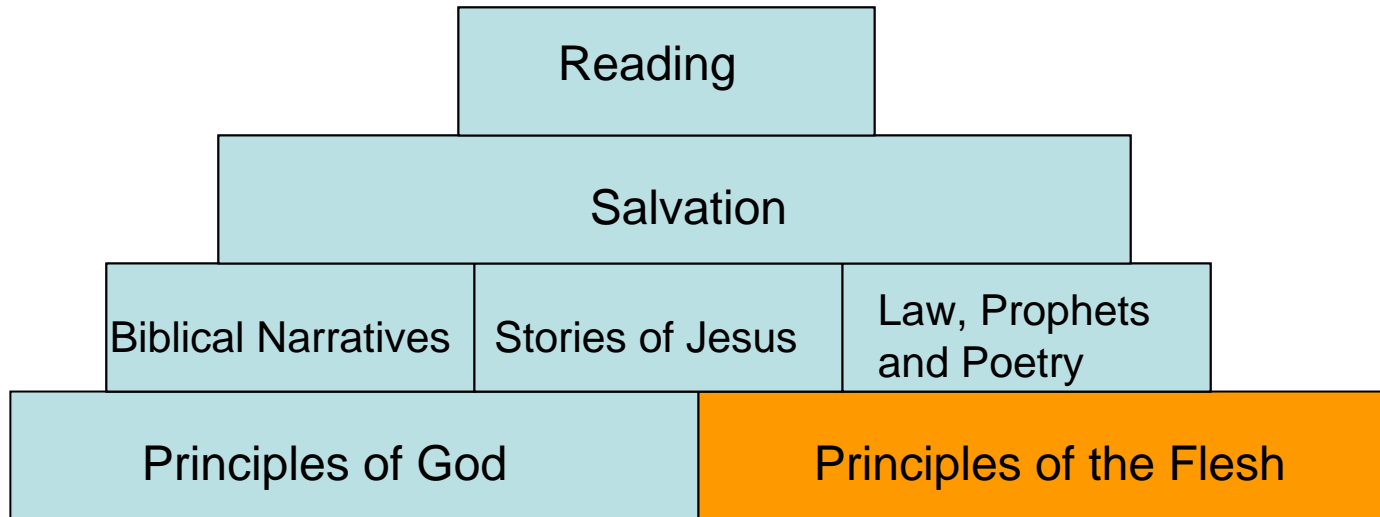
# What We Are Doing

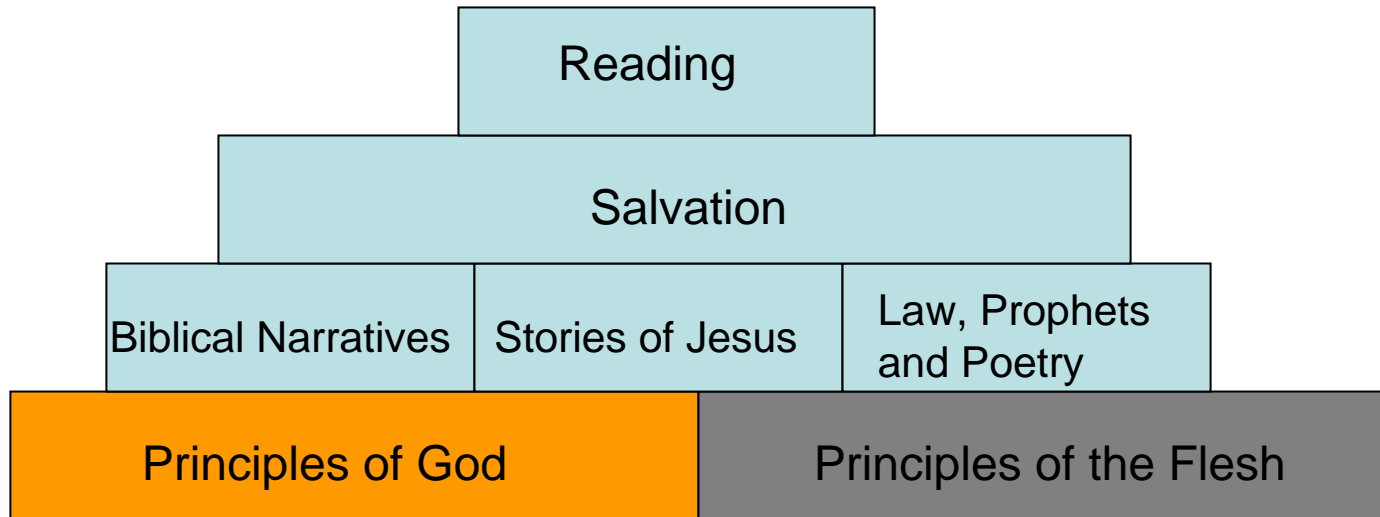
